Church revitalization is about bringing new life to existing congregations that are in maintenance or decline. Many congregations are in need of revitalization. Even church plants, in time, will need revitalization. The American Anglican Council's ReVive! Workshop will bring the passion and principles to any local congregation or diocese that, if applied, will bring new life. Even if a church has been in decline for many years, God is a God of life, not death, and he can revive the church! Having healthy, Great Commission Anglican churches is His will.

The cost for a ReVive! Workshop is: \$500 down to secure a seminar weekend and \$500 at the time of the seminar. The remaining six months of coaching are invoiced at \$125 a month for a total value of \$1750.00 plus expenses. Expenses are invoiced as incurred and include travel/lodging.
