This study guide is for Session 4: Rediscovering Evangelism

Session 4: Continuum - Demonstration

- According to a recent Barna study (Reviving Evangelism), some non-Christians say they might be more interested in Christianity if they had more evidence (44%) and the faith had a better reputation (34%). Practicing Christians, however, tend to underestimate the importance of evidence (14%) and reputation (23%) to non-Christians' interest. Based on this, how do you think demonstrating your faith both as evidence of its truth and giving it a better reputation, would help your evangelism efforts?
- 2. What are some ways Christians in general, and you specifically, could demonstrate more evidence of God's Kingdom to non-Christians?
- 3. Describe an experience you have had where God demonstrated himself to you in a supernatural way either before or after you became a Christian. If before, how did that help lead you to becoming a follower of Jesus? How helpful toward evangelism would it be for a non-Christian to have an experience of God?
- 4. Refer to your fishing pond list and for those who are "far from" God, identify ways you can start demonstrating His love to them specifically, this week, this month.

Close your group time with prayer in whatever way is most comfortable for you.

Practicum:

- 1. Prayerfully pick someone in your fishing pond who is not yet very receptive to the Gospel on the Engle Scale.
- 2. Prayerfully think of a way you can demonstrate the Gospel to them this week. Do it.
